APPALACHIAN MUSIC AND MOUNTAIN RAILROADS FALL GETAWAY

September 26—Sunday

Leave the Riviera Ballroom for West Virginia

5:00 –7:00 pm

Depart for Blackwater Falls State Park where you will have the opportunity to see the most photographed falls in West Virginia

Depart for Wisp Resort for a one hour pontoon tour with Wisp Outdoor Guides on Deep Creek Lake and enjoy fresh air while cruising the open water, box lunch is provided. After our boat ride we will take a 15 minute ride up Wisps Scenic Chair Lift for views of Deep Creek Lake. Watch people wiz by on the mountain coaster and you will have time once on top to enjoy the view and take a short walk to check out the Adventure Sports Center before riding the lift back down.

Then back on the coach for the 7 mile trip to Cheat Bridge where you will board the Cheat Mountain Salamander for a 3 hour ride on a vintage passenger train through the heart of the Cheat Mountain. At High Falls of the Cheat you will have 30 minutes to enjoy the falls. Back aboard to enjoy unspoiled mountain scenery, passing through a 1,800 foot long tunnel built



on an “S” curve and on into Elkins, WV.

At Whittaker Station you have the opportunity to leave the train and enjoy a breathtaking view of a vast wilderness area and enjoy a boxed lunch. You will have time to enjoy the authentic logging camp recreated by the volunteers of the Mountain State Railroad & Logging Historical Association. Once back at Cass you will have time to enjoy the Cass Historical Museum, Company Store, Shay Railroad Gift Shop, Last Run Restaurant, Cass Showcase or the town of Cass before boarding the coach back to Elkins.
