THE BILTMORE ESTATE**



NOVEMBER 18—THURSDAY (PACK AN OVERNIGHT BAG)

Board the bus at 7:00 am for North Carolina. A lunch stop will be made en route. Check into your overnight accommodations at the Village Inn in Clemmons, NC (336-766-9121). After check-in you will have a complimentary drink in the lounge before having dinner. (D)

NOVEMBER 19—FRIDAY

A breakfast buffet is included this morning. At 9:30 am, board the bus for a morning visit to Reynolda House Museum of American Art, built by R. J. Reynolds in 1914-1917 on a 1,067 acres estate. This 64-room country house offers a fine collection of furnishings and 18th, 19th and 20th Century American paintings, prints and sculpture by artists such as Mary Cassatt, Thomas Eakins and Andrew Wyeth. Lunch is on your own. Board the bus to continue to Asheville to check into the Hampton Inn. Board the bus at 5:30 for an evening at the beautiful Grove Park Inn. Dinner, a wonderful buffet, will be at 6:00. After dinner you will have a chance to relax and enjoy the resort before departing at 9:30 pm to return to your hotel. (B-D)

NOVEMBER 20—SATURDAY

After a Continental breakfast, board the bus at 9:30 am for a day of touring the Asheville area. Your step-on guide will take you on a wonderful tour of Asheville. At 3:30 you will return to the hotel to relax before boarding the bus at 5:30 pm for dinner at the Frankie Bones Restaurant. (B+D)
