**October 9—Saturday**

Travel to Fairhaven, MA with a stop at the Westport Rivers Winery for a tour, wine tasting and wine glass gift before arriving at the Hampton Inn for a two night stay. Dinner tonight is included.

**October 10—Sunday**

Enjoy a hot Hampton breakfast before touring Dorothy Cox Chocolates, established by the Cox family in 1928. Here you will learn about the family history, see a chocolate making demonstration in the back room with samples to enjoy! There will be time to browse through the gift shop before leaving for the National Cranberry Festival, a 40 year tradition in the "Cranberry Capitol of the World" - Carver, MA. This festival has everything cranberry with harvesting, bogs, food, crafts and more. Also enjoy entertainment and the Edaville Railroad with unlimited train rides along the beautiful crimson bogs. Lunch in on your own at the festival. Then it's on to an exhibit by Ocean Spray, the country's largest consumer of cranberries. After, stop in Plymouth to see "the rock" where the pilgrims landed, as well as the beautiful waterfront. Dinner tonight will be a "taste of two cultures" featuring favorites from both the English and the Native Americans as a food historian enlightens the event with interesting facts on cooking, ingredients, traditions and table manners (included).

After another Hampton breakfast, travel to Oakdale Farms, a country barn and garden shop with farm fresh produce and a great selection of New England food and craft products. After, board the bus to continue your trip back to Audubon.
