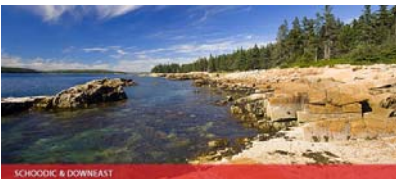

MAINE LOBSTER FESTIVAL

August 5—Thursday

Arrive at the Best Western Merry Manor Inn in Portland, ME for a one night stay. Lunch will be on your own in Mystic Village. A lobster roll choice dinner (other choices available) is included to-night.

August 6—Friday

After a full breakfast, leave the hotel for a mid-Maine coastal day. Meet your guide for a Boothbay Harbor tour and discover the beautiful coastal region including spectacular Ocean Point Drive, three lighthouses, salt water birds and local lobster fisherman. There will be time for lunch (on your own) and to explore the shops, eateries and beautiful views of Maine's rocky coastline. Then take a cruise to see the Penequid Lighthouse rising high above the pounding surf. Cruise by Seal Rocks, Ram Island and Burnt Island Lights, Christmas Cove and Fort William Henry. See playful seals, snug coves, busy harbors, old fishing villages, bustling boat yards and summer colonies. After, continue on to your hotel for the next two nights, the Rocktide Inn, Boothbay Harbor. Dinner tonight is included.

August 7—Saturday

After a full breakfast, leave for a full day on the Jewel Coast of Maine. The Lobster Festival festivities begin with a parade and will have marine exhibits, musical entertainment, demonstrations, contests, waterfront activities, arts and crafts and much more. Enjoy a twin lobster lunch (included) at the festival. Then see the Maine Lighthouse Museum with the largest collection of lighthouse artifacts in New England. Stop at the Maine State Prison Store. Dinner tonight is on your own in downtown Camden on the waterfront filled with shopping opportunities and many restaurants.

August 8—Sunday

After another full breakfast, you will leave for home. A stop will be made at Harraseeket Lobster Company where they will pack up lobsters to go before a quick photo-op at Maine's most photographed lighthouse, Nubble Light. A lunch stop will be made en route home.
