MAINE'S ROCKY COAST

September 12—Sunday

Arrive at the Ogunquit River Plantation in Ogunquit, ME for a one night stay. Dinner tonight is included.

September 13—Monday

Enjoy a deluxe Continental breakfast before setting off to discover the southern coast of Maine. Meet your guide for a tour of Kennebunkport and discover charming Kennebunkport including views of the Bush Estate, the Wedding Cake House and a tour of the Franciscan Monastery. You will hear the history of this Maine coastal community and have time for lunch (on your own) in Kennebunkport's waterfront area. Then it's on to the Henry Wadsworth Longfellow House for a tour of this American literary artist's home. Then enjoy a 90-minute lighthouse lover's scenic narrated cruise that begins in Portland Harbor. You will see the innermost harbor islands, forts, lobster boats, seals and seabirds, as well as lighthouses. Have an up close experience at Maine's oldest and most historic lighthouse—Portland Headlight. Then board the bus again to your destination for the evening—the Best Western Merry Manor in Portland. Dinner tonight is included.



September 14—Tuesday

After a full breakfast, leave the hotel for a full day in Maine's midcoastal region beginning at the Coastal Maine Botanical Gardens with native wildflowers, majestic ledge and stonework, pristine forests and tranquil water views. A guided tour is included, as well as a visit to the gift shop. Then travel to Boothbay Harbor for lunch (on your own) with time to walk around the area before continuing on to the Camden State Park with panoramic views from Mount Battie which overlooks the scenic Penobscot Bay and the Gulf of Maine. After a guided tour there will be time to walk around the town. Then board the bus for the Belfast Harbor Inn in Belfast where you will stay for the next two nights. Dinner tonight is included.

September 15—Wednesday

Enjoy a deluxe Continental breakfast before departing for Downeast Maine where you will have lunch (on your own) and time for shopping or visiting the galleries and museums in downtown Bar Harbor. Then it's off to Acadia National Park Visitor's Center to see exhibits and a film on the history and formation of this fascinating area. Meet your guide and be amazed by the natural wonders of this Maine Treasure. Travel to the Peak of Cadillac Mountain for breathtaking views of the mountains and the Atlantic Ocean. You can venture to Otter Point and experience the rocky cliffs jutting out into the crashing surf and witness the wonder of Sieur De Month Springs and the power of the surf at Thunder Hole. Tonight you will have a Maine Lobster dinner (included).

September 15—Wednesday

After another deluxe Continental breakfast, depart for home.
