



The following transportation services are available to Burlington County residents 60 years of age or older. Disabled residents under 60 must complete the SEN-HAN Disabled Rider Application. These are available on our website—www.scucs.org—or by contacting our office.

The majority of services operate between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Service is available in Burlington County and up to five miles over the County's borders. Service is provided on a door to door basis.

NON-EMERGENCY MEDICAL*

These are defined as rides to medical appointments at a physician's office, medical facility or hospital. Reservations can be made **two days to two weeks** in advance.

PERSONAL BUSINESS*

Transportation for personal business such as home/hospital visits, banking, entitlement offices, social events, etc. is available within five (5) miles of your home. Reservations can be made **three days** in advance.

*Hours of operation are 8:00 am to 4:00 pm, based on availability

EMPLOYMENT

Seniors and disabled residents can request private employment transportation between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday.

EDUCATION

Post secondary education transport is provided to senior and disabled Burlington County residents.

SPECIAL EVENTS

This group recreational transport is provided to Burlington County organizations, agencies and municipalities who have senior and/or disabled members.

A fee for service is assessed equal to SEN-HAN's expenses for the event.

SHOPPING

Shopping service is provided to 38 municipalities. One bus is dedicated to a different Zone each day, providing residents access to groceries and essentials within their Zone. Shopping service is not available in Willingboro, Medford Leas, Leisuretown and Evesham Township (Marlton). 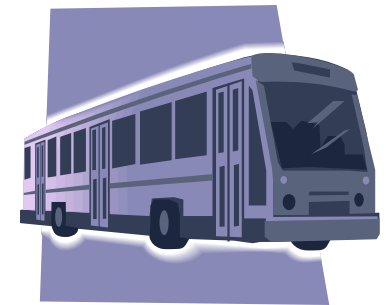
