
THE PURPOSE OF THE CEI PROGRAM



The Caregiver Education Initiative (CEI) is specifically designed to focus on the needs and concerns of the caregiver. Many people find themselves in a caregiving role for a relative or friend. Some can use assistance to make their caregiving role more manageable and effective. Let CEI help. There is no cost to you.

WHAT SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE?

1. A home visit with you and the person for whom you care.
2. A Registered Nurse will provide a full assessment of the caregiver's situation.
3. Together, the RN and the caregiver will develop an educational plan that may include instruction in the following areas:
 - Lifting and Transfers
 - Personal Care
 - Accessing Community Resources
 - Disease Education
 - Development of Coping Skills

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Caregiver:

- Is a care provider
- Lives with the care recipient or is responsible for their care
- Will benefit from education and support

Care Recipient:

- Is over age 18
- Requires the assistance of a caregiver to remain in the community
- Resides within Camden and Gloucester Counties



PROFESSIONAL HOME VISITS

The program allows up to three home visits by professionals in areas such as:

- Nursing
- Social Work
- Counseling

These professionals work with the caregiver to help make the caregiving role more manageable.
