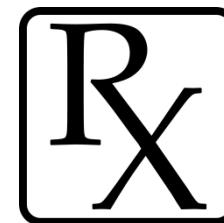

MEDICATION REMINDER PROGRAM

WHAT IS MEDICATION REMINDER?

- It is a service offered through the **Telephone Reassurance Program**, that seeks to assist Camden County residents who are sixty years of age and older that are homebound and living alone. A volunteer will call at a prearranged time to remind the individual to take his medications.

WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES OF MEDICATION REMINDER?

- It helps to ensure the person takes his medicine as prescribed. It affirms someone *does care* by sharing a few minutes in friendly conversation. The call provides peace of mind to family, friends and participants.

IS THERE A CHARGE?

- No. Telephone Reassurance is a service offered free of charge to seniors in Camden County

At A Glance...

- Services includes an intake and assessment of each referral by both a registered nurse and social worker.
- An individualized emergency plan will be developed by a registered nurse and social worker.
- Each participant deemed appropriate for the program will be matched with a trained volunteer.
- Each volunteer will receive an orientation training which will include the needs of the participant and emergency procedures.
- Scheduled brief telephone calls are made by friendly volunteers at a mutually agreed upon time daily.
