

THE PURPOSE OF THE CEI PROGRAM

The Caregiver Education Initiative (CEI) is specifically designed to focus on the needs and concerns of the caregiver. This program offers caregivers one on one counseling by a social worker to improve effectiveness and well-being in the caregiver role. These services are offered at no cost to you.

SERVICES AVAILABLE

1. A home visit with you and the person for whom you care.
2. A Registered Nurse will provide a full assessment of the caregiver's situation.
3. Together, the RN and the caregiver will develop a plan to address the caregiver's needs. Services may include:
 - Information on Community Resources
 - Stress Management
 - Managing Behavioral Difficulties
 - Disease Education
 - Development of Coping Skills

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Caregiver:

- Lives with the care recipient or is responsible for their care
- Will benefit from education and support

Care Recipient:

- Is over age 18
- Requires the assistance of a caregiver to remain in the community
- Resides in Camden County

PROFESSIONAL HOME VISITS

- Nursing
- Social Work
- Counseling

These professionals work with the caregiver to help make the caregiving role more manageable.
