

ARE YOU A CAREGIVER?

If you are taking care of a family member or friend and feel worn out, we may be able to help you through the Respite Care Program. RESPITE *means relief* and that is what the Respite Program means for you! It will give you time to take care of your shopping, errands or just give you time to relax. RESPITE provides service for you when you are fatigued and under heavy stress from taking care of an elderly or disabled person.

SERVICES AVAILABLE

CARE PLANNING

The Respite Care Program is designed to consider the needs of non-working and working caregivers, as well as the care recipient. It works with you to develop an individual *Care Plan* to address your individual situation.

RESPITE

Service can range from a few hours a week to much more. Evening, weekend, and vacation care coverage may also be scheduled through the program. Help is provided by trained substitute caregivers such as:

- Home Health Aides
- Medical Day Care Centers
- Temporary in-patient care in a licensed nursing home or assisted living facility
- Adult Family Care Home

We can also provide:

- Quick response to family emergencies
- Peer support group referral

CAREGIVER EDUCATION

A personalized Caregiver Education Program is part of the service package offered to program participants. This program offers caregivers one-on-one counseling to improve their effectiveness and well-being in the caregiver role. The program offers:

- Disease Education
- Nutritional Education
- Transfer and Lifting Techniques
- Information on assistive technology
- Social Work Counseling
- Stress Reduction Techniques
- Behavior Modification Techniques
- And much more!
