

## ABOUT THE PERSONAL CARE PROGRAM

The Title III Personal Care Program is managed by Senior Citizens United Community Services, Inc. (SCUCS). SCUCS is a long-time provider of social services in Camden County, with a strong commitment to enhancing the lives of the older people in our community.

This service is available for up to eight weeks at no cost to clients. The person needing care may live alone or with relatives. There may be a Waiting List when the demand is heavy.

The Personal Care Coordinator will be glad to discuss the program with callers and answer any questions you may have. She will arrange for a nurse to visit you at home and determine what care you need.

A trained home health aide will visit you and assist you with:

- Personal care needs such as bathing, shampooing hair, etc.
- Changing linens
- Laundry
