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DOWNEAST BEAUTY OF MAINE

Day #1

Stop for a photo-op at the historic Portland Headlight, first lit by whale oil in 1791, set on a bluff, boasting sensational views of fabulous Casco Bay and the Calendar Islands. Arrive at the Best Western Merry Manor Inn, South Portland, ME for a one night stay. Dinner tonight is included.

Day #2 – Full Breakfast

Maine's rugged, rocky coast and picturesque lighthouses - what a combo! The scene unfolds as you cruise from Portland's scenic harbor seeing the Calendar Islands, coastal forts, Maine lobster boats, playful seals and an array of seabirds. View as many as seven lighthouses including an up-close experience at Maine's oldest and historic lighthouse, Portland Headlight, proudly perched on one of Maine's famous rocky outcrops overlooking this beautiful harbor. Take time for lunch (on your own) in the delightful coastal village of Boothbay Harbor filled with shops, eateries and beautiful views of Maine's rocky coastline. Meet your guide and see why the Boothbay Harbor Region is the "Soul of the Maine Coast". Explore quiet coves, rocky shores, meandering country roads and beautiful lighthouses. Discover this beautiful coastal region including spectacular Ocean Point Drive, three lighthouses, salt water birds and local lobster fishermen. After dinner (included), arrive at the Ramada Inn, Ellsworth, ME for a three night stay.

Day #3 – Deluxe Continental Breakfast

Meet your guide and be amazed by the natural wonders of Bar Harbor and Acadia National Park, celebrating its 100th anniversary. Travel to the peak of Cadillac Mountain for breathtaking views of the mountains and the Atlantic. Venture to Otter Point and experience the rocky cliffs jutting out into the crashing surf. Witness the wonder of Sieur De Mont Springs and the power of the surf at Thunder Hole. Join in celebrating the 100th Anniversary of Acadia National Park's rich natural and cultural history. Visit the waterfront town of Bar Harbor - filled with shops, eateries, galleries and museums. Take time to explore and enjoy lunch on your own. Then breath in the fresh Maine air on a leisurely, horse-drawn carriage ride along Acadia's first trails. These trails, chosen by John D. Rockefeller himself, were designed with the landscape in mind, making sure they flowed beautifully and effortlessly into their natural surroundings. After, tuck into a mouth-watering, ocean-fresh Maine lobster feast!

Day #4 – Deluxe Continental Breakfast

Experience the famous, ruggedly beautiful Acadian coast from Acadia National Park to Campobello, New Brunswick. Travel through Maine's blueberry country and discover the meaning of real 'Down East'. Enjoy lunch (on your own) at a famous local seafood restaurant. After, tour the summer cottage of Franklin Delano Roosevelt, located on a beautiful oceanfront property in New Brunswick, Canada (passports required for this stop). Learn about FDR's many summers on Campobello Island, both as a child and later as an adult with his family. Today Roosevelt Campobello International Park serves as a memorial to FDR and a symbol of cooperation between the U.S. and Canada. Then visit West Quoddy Light where the sun first hits the United States, and visit Maine's famous striped lighthouse and Visitor's Center. Dinner tonight is included.
