# QUECHEE BALLOON FESTIVAL

## 37th Annual Hot Air Balloon Celebration

### Day #1

Visit the Apple Barn and Country Bake Shop and enjoy panoramic views on a ride to the top of the orchard and hear the history of the orchard and the area. Dig into a slice of their signature apple pie ala mode. Visit the wonderful bake shop. Then arrive at the Inn of the Six Mountains, Killington, VT for a two night stay. Dinner is included tonight.

### Day #2 – Deluxe Continental Breakfast

Breathe in the fresh air at Billings Farm Museum of Vermont's rural life with exhibits covering the 19th Century to today. Tour through the charming 1890 farm house located in the rolling Vermont hills. Experience the working dairy operation, walk through the heirloom gardens and take a wagon ride. Then it's on to Woodstock Village, named the "quintessential New England village", the town is chock full of charming Americana, including a covered bridge smack in the center of town and a village green surrounded by restored Georgian, Federal Style and Greek Revival homes. Take time for lunch on own, browsing the shops and a walk through the covered bridge. Then there will be a photo-op at Quechee Gorge, Vermont's "little Grand Canyon", nestled in the Green Mountains. Check out Vermont's largest collection of hand crafted items and yummy local foods at Quechee Gorge Village and Country Store, as well as the antique mall. Then it's on to the Quechee Hot Air Balloon Festival, a breathtaking sight, with Balloon Flight at 6:00 pm (weather permitting). See the exciting "Balloon Glow" after dark. There will be tons of entertainment including live music - R & B, Swing, Seventies, Jazz, guitarists, vocalists, clowns, jugglers, mimes, and comedy acts (subject to change). See over 50 Vermont craft displays. You will receive a voucher for dinner to use at your choice of dining options at the fair.

### Day #3 – Deluxe Continental Breakfast

Stop in the 1946 Vermont Country Store, listed on the National Historic Register, with fascinating merchandise and New England antiques before heading home.
