

## Community Services


### Lending Closet

- Medical appliances are available on a **temporary basis** to Camden County senior residents 60+ years of age in need. Items include: wheelchairs, canes, walkers, shower chairs, rollators, knee walkers, and commodes. Adult diapers and bed pads are also available on a very limited basis.



### Food Pantry

- Non-perishable food items are available for low income Camden County residents.
- Assistance is available once a month and provides 6 days of meals.



### Shut-In Shopping

- This bi-weekly shopping service is available to **homebound** seniors 60+ years of age based on the availability of volunteer shoppers. Clients are responsible for the cost of all purchases.
