Adult Family Care is an affordable residential alternative to placement in a Long term Care Facility. AFC is a Medicaid Waiver program sponsored by SCUCS. Assisted living services are provided in the comfort of the private home of a trained caregiver. It is for any individual who cannot live independently but requires medical supervision. The goal is to promote and maintain maximum personal independence. Perhaps you may have clients that would prefer an AFC home to a facility
