2016 CASINO REVENUE FUND APPLICATION

As posted on your vehicle, the Public Hearing on the Casino Revenue Fund's 2016 Senior Citizens and Disabled Residents Transportation Assistance Program (SCDRTAP) application was held on June 18, 2015 in the conference room at SCUCS, 537 Nicholson Road, Audubon.

The Casino Revenue Fund allocation is based on the 2010 senior citizen census. In 2016, Camden County will be receiving \$26,795 more than in 2015. The allocation is over \$1,000,000 less than that received in 2008.

The "Friends Helping Friends" day at local Boscov's will be held on October 20th. Tickets are still only \$5 and entitle the holder to 25% off most merchandise.



Last year the agency sold 302 tickets resulting in a net income of \$1,510 to be used towards services for the needy residents of Camden County.
