



Colorado Springs Rail Getaway Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Denver - Colorado Springs

Arrive in **Denver**, the Capital of Colorado known as the "mile high city." Meet your Tour Director and take a short ride south to Colorado Springs, a picturesque city situated at the foot of famous Pikes Peak. Check into your hotel for a five-night stay. Day 2: USAF Academy - Olympic Training Center

This morning visit the **US Air Force Academy** located at the foot of the majestic Colorado Rocky Mountains. The Academy is Colorado's most visited man-made attraction and home to cadets participating in the officer-training program each year. Stop at the Visitor Center to learn about and see exhibits on cadet life and the Air Force. Also see the unique Cadet Chapel, a national landmark with its 17 gleaming aluminum spires soaring skyward. Later visit the US Olympic Training Center, where more than 15,000 athletes train annually. The complex is able to provide housing, dining, recreational and training facilities for up to 557 coaches and athletes at one time. This evening enjoy "The Springs" at your own pace.

Day 3: Royal Gorge - Cripple Creek

Journey south today to experience some of the most arresting scenic sights in all of American railroading aboard the Royal Gorge Train. Today's rail journey will take you from Canon City to Parkdale along the Arkansas River through the scenic Royal Gorge. Enjoy dramatic views of the Royal Gorge Bridge, the world's highest suspension bridge. Later, visit the historic goldmining town of Cripple Creek, still the fourth largest gold mine in the world. Stroll the historic streets before returning to Colorado Springs. Tonight enjoy dinner with your fellow travelers at a local restaurant.

Enjoy the day at your own pace. Colorado Springs boasts more than 300 days of sunshine each year and offers visitors a great variety of attractions. An optional tour will be available.

Day 5: Pikes Peak - Garden of the Gods - Broadmoor

At 14,110 feet, Pikes Peak stands tall in Colorado's western sky. Today board the Pikes Peak Cog Railway in specially designed cars which take you to the summit providing unparalleled views of this amazing area. On a clear day you can see 75 miles to Denver and over 100 miles to New Mexico. Later visit Old Colorado City, site of the area's original settlement. Another highlight today will be a visit to the scenic Garden of the Gods. Located where the Great Plains meet the mighty Rockies, this 1,300-acre park is home to towering sandstone formations as well as fabulous floral displays. This afternoon visit and tour the iconic Broadmoor, the historic resort hotel was originally built in 1891. Tonight join your fellow travelers for a fun filled Farewell Dinner at popular local restau-
